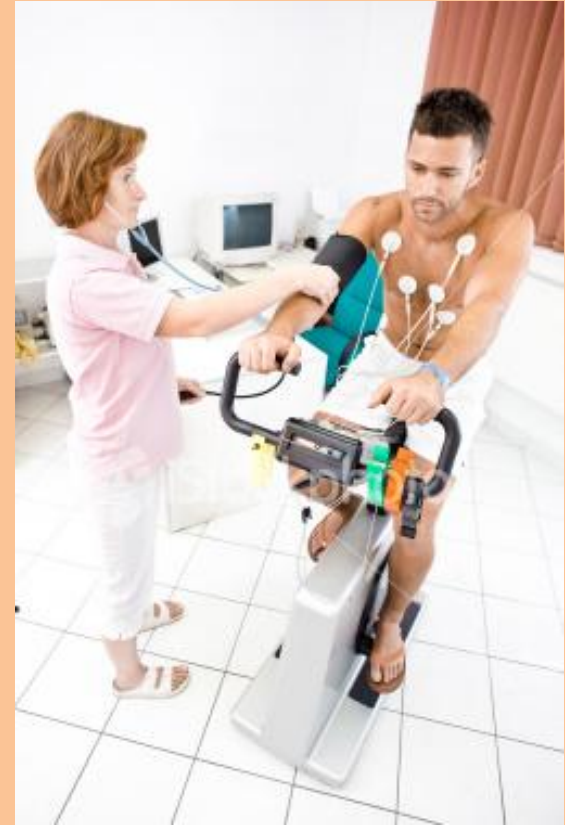

- The nurses most important responsibility is to tend to the patient whether an individual family or group.



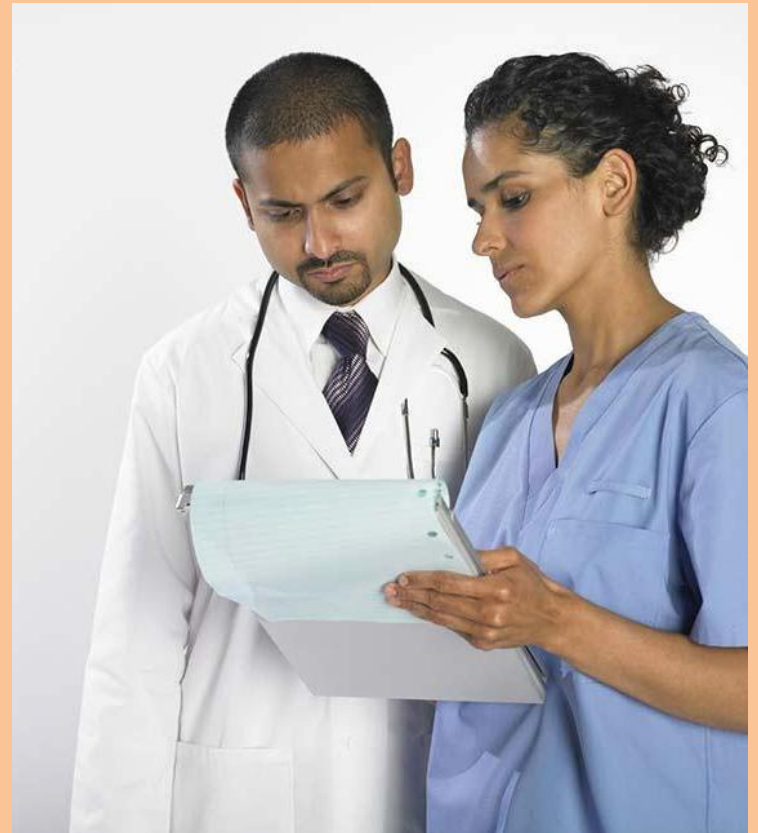
Safety & Rights of Patient
